

Job Description Cattle Division-Cattle Truck Driver Part Time Northeast Iowa

SUMMARY:

The Cattle Division of Lynch Livestock seeks a part-time driver (potential to go full time) working 3 days of the week. The Cattle Driver will be home nightly. The driver should live in Northeast Iowa, as routes will be from Northeast Iowa to Southern Iowa to Central Wisconsin. Cattle experience is preferred.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Follow all directions given of the load dispatch schedule vie a hard copy, phone, text, conversation or email with the dispatcher.
- Must be able to load and unload cattle.
- Communicate with producers and fellow employees of the schedule.
- Must be able to schedule loads as well as work around other people's schedules.
- Must have proper knowledge of cattle to assure proper livestock hauling as well as having sorting and loading skills.
- Manage loads to ensure equipment is loaded legally from a weight and safety standpoint.
- Coordinate all load information with the Cattle Division Dispatcher.
- Keep an accurate FMCSA driver's log
- Perform pre and post inspections daily.
- Handles all loads and equipment in such a manner to keep free from damage and freight claims.
- Follow the FMSCA and Company Policy. Always work together with your team to keep everyone efficient and safe.
- Performs other duties as needed and/or assigned
- Must be capable of regular and predictable attendance
 - o Able to work overtime and weekends as needed
 - o Able to work holidays as needed

- Must have a valid Class A CDL
- The company will require employee to get Tanker Endorsement within the first 30 days of employment.
