Animal Care Technician/Early Pig Care Specialist

SUMMARY:

Responsible for maintaining a healthy environment for piglets.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Daily evaluation and care of small and fallow pigs
- Develop and implement strategies and fill plans on a site by site basis
- Identify and treat sick pigs
 - Monitor health and provide feedback
 - Administer water medications as needed
- Mat and gruel feeding
- Maintain feeder adjustments and water management
- Aide in receiving pigs
 - Sort
 - Grade
- Ensure timely euthanasia is performed as needed
- Monitor ventilation
- Maintain records and reports
- Performs other duties as needed and/or assigned
- Must be capable of regular and predictable attendance
 - Able to work overtime as needed
 - Able to work weekends as needed
 - Able to work holidays as needed

- Able to work in confinement buildings
- Able to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Able to perform general repairs in office, yards building, and grounds
